Dear Parents,

The Invictus Games is an international adaptive multi-sport event, created by Prince Harry, in which wounded, injured or sick armed services personnel and their associated veterans take part in sports including wheelchair



basketball, sitting volleyball, and indoor rowing. Named after Invictus, Latin for "unconquered" or "undefeated", the event was inspired by the Warrior Games, a similar event held in the United States. The first Invictus Games took place in September 2014 at the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park in London, United Kingdom.

The Games will show that these "wounded warriors" have not been conquered by their physical and emotional wounds. The Games are designed to help soldiers cope with, and heal from, their health challenges. The Invictus Games highlight the positive impact that sport, physical exercise and participation can have on mental health and wellbeing. It uses sport to build resilience as we are learning all the time about resilience and its links to mental and physical health.

We need talk to our children about the indefatigable human spirit, which is at the heart of the Invictus Games, we need to help all children grow and understand that power of resilience and the unconquered human spirit can help us through life- especially during testing times.

Jesus Christ told us that we would have tough times, but He also reminded us that He would always be with us. If He's always with us, then He will help us. Be strong in Him and seek peace by keeping your mind on Him. We must stop dwelling on the bad. Resilient Christians look past their troubles and put their mind on Christ.


BOOK WEEK
