BISHOP'S RELIGIOUS ARTS PRIZE 2021

The 2021 Bishop's Religious Arts Prize is open to all school students from Kindergarten to Year 8 in the Diocese of Broken Bay. In 2021, The Bishop's Religious Arts Prize includes the mediums of Film AND Visual Art (in a two-dimensional element) to reflect on and respond to a Gospel story. This year students may choose a story or significant verse from any of the four Gospels. The Gospels allow us to enter the world of Jesus, who is presented as a Jewish religious teacher.

Students are working in class on these projects and by the end of Week 2, Term 3, students will submit work for judging at school. One finalist is awarded at each Stage (ES1-3) and these artworks will then be submitted and judged by a panel and Bishop Anthony by the end of Week 10, Term 3.


