


**HBL Update Week 6**

#### Well-being Wednesdays - Screen Free

Due to the overwhelmingly positive response to our screen-free day, we will be continuing this for the remainder of the term. Teachers will set the work for the day but there will be no screens and work can be completed off-line. Attached to this update is another grid that focuses on Science Week, with activities that can be completed as a family or individually without the need for technology. These tasks **DO NOT HAVE** to be completed. However, you may choose to do some or all of them. #### Zoom/Video conferencing protocols for students.

Many parents have asked for more explicit rules around a student's responsibility and expected behaviour during classzooms. While each teacher set ground rules at the beginning of the term and developed their own class set of rules surrounding Zoom, we understand the need for an overarching set of protocols. A one page handout outlining the school's expectations is attached to this update and we ask you share this with your children. It will be uploaded to all the learning platforms and teachers will refer to it as well as their grade/class specific rules.

#### **Vinnies Winter Sleepout**

Next Friday 27th August from 6.30 to 8.00 pm, will be hosting our very own Vinnies Virtual Winter Sleep Out. We invite all students and families from Kindergarten to Year 6 to join in, as we get a glimpse into the realities of homelessness by 'sleeping rough' for a night.

We will come together to raise important funds and awareness for the most vulnerable people in our local communities. We hope that this experience will challenge your sense of home and offer unique insights into the complex issues faced by people experiencing homelessness.

On the night, we will be running a trivia competition - Are You Smarter than a Prouillian? Throughout the night, families are invited to participate and we will crown a winner of the 5 rounds (Geography, Natural World, Entertainment, Science and Sport) (Zoom Link for Vinnies Virtual Sleepout and Trivia Night)

## Prouille Video Conferencing/Zoom Guidelines for parents and students

Prouille Catholic School staff members will use Zoom for video conferencing **(VC)** with students and parents under the following conditions:-

- 1. Parents should be aware of and be present during a student's participation in Zoom.
  - **a. Parents** should be aware of the time of the **VC** and are requested, where possible, to provide supervision of children's participation. This reduces the risk of inappropriate behaviour, language or content being shared.
  - **b. Students** should inform parents when they are about to join a **VC** and who the **VC** host is. This is a good habit to develop for <u>all</u> primary school students online interactions.
- 2. The Video Conference is a classroom and the same school behaviour expectations apply.
- 3. Students and parents must be appropriately dressed for learning.
  - a. Students must be dressed in clothing appropriate for learning, i.e. no pyjamas or revealing clothing.
  - b. Parents present must be dressed in clothing appropriate for a school setting.
- 4. Real names must be used in all Video Conferences.
  - a. Students will only enter a VC using their own name and are to be aware that all interactions, messaging, gestures and language used during a VC are "school appropriate" even if you are not on school grounds.
  - **b. Parents** will ensure students are using their own name. (First name or first name and second initial.)
- 5. Screens, backgrounds, chat functions and other tools should only be used on the instruction from the teacher.
  - a. Students will ensure that their background is a plain single colour or a blank wall in your home.
  - **b. Students** can change the background at the request of the teacher however, school appropriate content must be used or you will be removed to the waiting room.
  - **c. Students** may **not**, at any time, record or take photos of the teacher or other participants during the video conference.
  - **d. Students** must comply with the CSBB Responsible use of ICT guidelines sent to families at the beginning of the year.

Together we can challenge our actions and attitudes towards homelessness in our community and our world.

Every night in Australia, a child asks their parents "Where are we going to sleep tonight?" And mum and dad don't have an answer.

Before COVID-19 hit, there were more than 25,000 Australian children under the age of 18 who were facing homelessness each night. Six year old Olivia was one of them. Olivia and her father Darren spent many months moving from couch to floor, uncle to aunty, looking for somewhere safe to stay.

When Darren lost his job, he also lost his home. He was forced to move constantly between friends and family members. He called on everyone he could to make sure Olivia wasn't sleeping on the street. When he could scrape together the money, they stayed in motels.

Although Olivia may have been too young to fully comprehend the situation, she understood enough to be worried. Every day she asked her dad where they were going.

Night after night she was scared she'd have to sleep in the car, or in the park, or on a living room floor. These are formative years in a child's life, and to spend them in fear can leave lasting scars.

On Friday 27th August we are running our Virtual Vinnies Sleep Out @Home to empathise with rough sleepers and raise money for the Vinnies Winter Appeal. Our Zoom will be live for all students & Families from 6:30pm -8pm.

- Have a backyard campfire / fire pit & chat about the issues facing people doing it tough.
- 2. Pitch a tent / sleepout on your trampoline or in your garage for part of the night

- 4. Sit outside in your garden on some newspaper / cardboard for a part of the night & talk
- 5. Have some hot soup / hot chocs/ toasted marshmallows & chat about the experience
