STEP-UP/ PROMOTIONS MEET AND GREET YOUR 2022 TEACHER

Today your children met their 2022 classroom teacher in their 2022 classroom. We welcomed new families to the school who will be joining us in Years 1 to 6 next year. Please be assured that teachers take great care to place your children into the right cohort and class if there happens to be two streams.

Many different factors are taken into consideration when making decisions about the most beneficial mixture in the cohort. Social needs, academic considerations, adjustments and equity are just some of the factors. Parents do not get to request teachers for their child as classes are made based on student needs and not parent preferences.

Each child has gone home with a letter that names their class teacher and outlines the process for booking into the Mathematics Assessment Interview through Compass for Monday the 31st January. The letter also has a list of items required specific to each grade on the reverse side.

SEMESTER 2 REPORTS

The students' Semester 2 reports will be available on the Compass Parental Portal from 4.00pm Friday 10th December. In response to changes to the learning and teaching environment during COVID-19, all schools have needed to adjust their assessment and reporting processes. The Semester report will look different, while complying with government requirements. This 2021 second semester report recognises and reflects three key areas: English, Mathematics and Religious Education. The 2022 first semester report will return to documenting progress in all Key Learning Areas.

Hello Parents, young instrumentalists, and all aspiring musicians!

We are so delighted that you are thinking of joining your schools amazing Band Program!

But before you make a decision on joining or continuing to play, we wanted to take the opportunity to introduce you to the type of instruments you can learn in the Band Program.

Step 4: If you would like to come and try an instrument you are wanting to play. Come and have a blow test at my studio in Roseville on Saturday 11th December and the following week

Each band needs to have a balance of different types of instruments:

High instruments - like flutes, clarinets, oboes and trumpets. Middle instruments - like alto saxophones and horns. Low instruments - like baritones, trombones, tubas and bass guitars and Percussion - like drum kits, timpani and xylophones.
