Following feedback from last year, we are going to be holding our beginning of the year Parent Information Nights in a slightly different way this year

When the carnival is over, children who are not coming back to school or children that have completed their events and are signed out by a parent, can do as they wish. However, during official school time, we ask that children eat their own food which they bring from home.






